



“Guided city walk through Graz incl. Armoury of Styria” (approx. 3,5 hours)

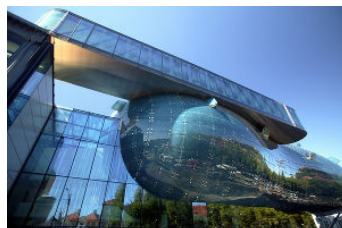

A panorama of old and new. From the **clock tower** with its unusual hands to the island made of glass and steel. Visit of the **Armoury** - the world famous arsenal of Styria. Have a sensuous experience of a captivating city!

Visit of the KUNSTHAUS Graz (approx. 1,5 hrs)



Something extra-terrestrial in the World Heritage site of Graz? Like a huge bluish bubble the landmark of new Graz is hovering above the right bank of the river Mur. Since October 2003, **Kunsthau**s - affectionately called "**a friendly alien**" by its creators, Peter Cook and Colin Fournier - has attracted people with spectacular architecture and changing exhibitions of contemporary art. Moreover, Kunsthaus is a symbol of the harmonious co-existence of old and new in Graz. After all, it is growing out of the Eisernes Haus which in 1848 caused quite a stir as one of the first cast-iron buildings on the Continent.

“A visit to the farmer’s market” (guided tour – approx. 2 hours)



Freshly harvested fruits and vegetables, homemade bread and cakes, delicious sausages and ham, honey, flowers and last but not least pumpkin seed oil – the „black gold of Styria“. Enjoy a stroll to the farmers’ market and taste the famous dark oil, a glass of Styrian wine and a little snack.

“Where the white horses run...” (bus tour – half day - approx. 5 hours)



Over the hills to the home of the famous white horses of the Spanish Riding School — the **Lipizzan stud farm** — in West Styria. This afternoon trip isn't only for horse fanciers, though. It's for anyone who has a taste for the play of the light on the hills.....on the way back take a glimpse of **St. Barbara’s Church** in Bärnbach, with the playful multicolored decorations by Friedensreich Hundertwasser.

"South Styrian Wine Route" (bus tour – full day – approx. 8 hours)



Here, beneath poplars and chestnut trees, where the **Klapotetz** beats time, life revolves around wine. An internationally more and more popular variety of local white wine reach the peak of maturity amidst the gentle hills of southern Styria. A **wine-tasting** will help you acquire a taste for it. During the visit to the pumpkin seed oil mill you will be let into the secret of the „**black gold of Styria**“ – the production of the famous pumpkin seed oil. And to round it off you definitely have to try the Styrian fried chicken, the **"Backhendl"**, a **MUST** on this culinary tour. The **episcopal Seggau Castle** is amidst the most noteworthy sights of Styria.
